SPIRITUAL CLASSICS

Some writings from across the centuries are helpful. For example: *Julian of Norwich* (1342-1416), from whom the Julian Meetings takes its name because of her teaching on prayer, was a solitary and wrote *Revelations of Divine Love*. The revelations were 16 visions and her meditations on these mystical experiences.

The Cloud of Unknowing by an unknown English medieval writer, shows the development of prayer and contemplation as a discipline. Teresa of Avila was a 16th century Spanish mystic as was St John of the Cross, a supreme poet of Christianity's mystical tradition. Abbé Henri de Tourville was a 19th century French spiritual director; his letters to his penitents are full of insight and encouragement. Some translations are better than others. These are some versions that JM members have found helpful, including three series of spiritual classics which are good introductions to each writer and good resources for 'lead-ins' to silence.
